

LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION

To become confident when speaking to friends and adults in a small group.
Learn to listen to others & take turns when speaking in a small group.
Listen to well known stories with attention.
Explore rhythmic patterns.
Use descriptive words.

LITERACY

READING:

Handle books carefully, enjoying books when sharing with an adult, a friend or alone.
Learn letter names and sounds.
Recognise words that are important - like names.

WRITING:

Recognise that pictures are different to words and that marks mean something.
Build the confidence to have a go at writing.
Write recognisable letters and their own name.

MATHEMATICS

NUMBER:

Understand one to one correspondence.
Join in number songs and rhymes.
Learn about number through practical activities including simple computer programs.
Recognise, order and write numbers up to 5.

SHAPE & SPACE:

Children to use mathematical language to describe characteristics of everyday objects and shapes
Children to recognise, create and describe patterns

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Understand when to be still and when to move. Explore different ways of travelling,
Begin to think about how to be healthy by eating healthily and keeping clean,
Understand that other children need space when doing P.E.
Become more able to fasten own clothes.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & MORAL DEVELOPMENT

Develop self confidence and self esteem.
Understand that other people have needs.
Develop independence in choosing and carrying out activities.
Understand the need to look after the classroom.
Learn how to behave in the classroom and playground.
Understand that people believe in different things and that they have different cultures.

EXPRESSIVE ART and DESIGN

ART:

Explore colour mixing using paint.
Learn to use a range of art materials.
Learn to use a paint brush.
Explore the works of artists such as Kandinsky

DANCE:

Use imaginative movements to represent different animals through dance.

MUSIC:

Begin to develop a sense of rhythm.
Learn songs off by heart and add simple actions.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY:

Consider, design and plan construction projects.
Use a range of equipment and recycled materials to build and develop plans and ideas.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

GEOGRAPHY:

Follow simple directions around the classroom and playground.

Begin to record the changes in the weather.

SCIENCE:

Look carefully at similarities and differences, patterns and change.

Become enquiring and curious when finding out about different materials and objects.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY:

Use simple computer programs.
Learn to use a mouse confidently.
Learn how to use a camera with confidence.

HISTORY:

To talk about past events such as the summer holidays.
