

## English

Children will develop skills to make a 'golden sentence'. Children will develop their phonic skills. Handwriting will be practised regularly using the St John's cursive script. Children shall explore fiction and non-fiction books. They will write their own stories based on a class story book, where the focus will be on writing a beginning, middle and end. They will use drama to inspire their writing. They will learn how to write information texts including how to use simple labels and captions.

## R.E.

Children will be learning about Judaism. Children will explore Jewish artefacts and symbols. Children will find out about Jewish worship. Children will look at different types of celebration and will have the opportunity to share how they celebrate with their families.

## Maths

Children will practise counting to 100 from any number. Children will practise their number formation. Number lines and practical resources will be used to help children order and compare numbers. Children will develop their addition and subtraction knowledge. Children will learn about length, weight and capacity as well as developing their problem solving skills in different contexts.

## P.E.

Children will build on co-operation skills through working with other pupils and sharing equipment. They will develop sending, receiving and aiming skills. They will explore different balances on large and small body parts.

## Geography

Children will explore clothes from around the world. Children will develop their understanding of the different types of clothes people wear for different weather conditions.

## Science

Children will explore changes across the four seasons. They will observe and describe weather associated with each season. Children will explore how the day length varies depending on the season. Prediction, observation, recording and analysing skills will be developed.

## History

Children shall develop an understanding of chronological order. Children will explore clothes from the past.

## Art

Children shall explore different patterns. Children will learn about the famous artist Kandinsky. Children will create their own patterns.

## Music

Children will learn about pulse, rhythm and pitch in different songs and nursery rhymes.

## Computing

Children will create a short film based on instructions. They will learn to learn what algorithms are and how they are implemented on a digital device.

## PSHE

Children will learn about making healthy choices. They will learn about hygiene, healthy eating and exercise. They will continue to develop their social skills.
