CORRECT UNIFORM

Please click <u>here</u> to find details of the correct uniform items your child should be wearing to school daily. Please ensure **no jewellery** is worn to school including earrings as they are not permitted to be worn during the school day for health and safety reasons. In addition, please remember for years 1- 6, a school tie must be worn everyday and top buttons should be done up. All uniform also needs to be named so it can go back to it's correct owner if lost.





ONLINE SAFETY

It is advisable to make sure your child understands that they can talk to you if they see anything that makes them feel uncomfortable online. If they use YouTube, to make it safer for them please explore YouTube together and see what they like to watch. To add some safety measures you can;

Select Restricted Mode - this is an additional setting (when logged in via a Google account) to restrict the availability of mature content.
