TIMES TABLES

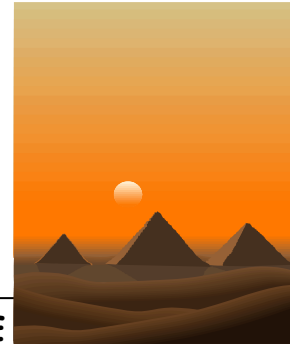
- To learn the 3- and 6-times tables
