Option 1:

Make your own windmill!

Create your very own miniature model of Shirley windmill for everyone to admire.

You could be as creative as you like using all types of materials to make it such as:

- Papier mache
- Kitchen rolls
- Card and paint!

Try to include all the features of the windmill and provide a short information poster about it to explain what you did.

Option 2:

Visit the windmill

Have you actually been inside the windmill?

Take this as an opportunity to go and explore what Shirley windmill used to do and record what you learnt.

You could:

- Do a photo diary
- Create an information poster.

Option 3:

Shirley now and then.

How has the Wickham Road (from the Library to the Crown) changed over the years?

Create a book/ time line of Shirley and compare how it has changed over the past 100 years (new buildings, changing of shops etc.)

You could:

- Take pictures of the high street and compare them to how the high street used to look.
- Find out about a particular building that has changed e.g. the library.

Option 4:

What makes Shirley special?

Create a collage of what makes Shirley special. Collect pictures, brochures, images of different aspects of Shirley and create your own big collage to show how our community works together.

Try to present your work electronically. Think about using a photo journey, a video or PowerPoint. Be creative, get researching!
