Recount writing

*The children will write a recount based on our exciting Dinosaur Workshop. They will write in the past tense and think about adding detail to create interest. **Poetry**

*The children will create their own poem based on a book 'Stomp, Dinosaur, Stomp'. They will use a variety of adjectives and verbs as well as a repetitive phrase.

Non-chronological report

*The children will write facts about dinosaurs using information that they research. They will include conjunctions to extend their sentences.

Fiction writing - Dinosaurs and all that Rubbish *Children will explore the story and develop their writing skills through various writing tasks.

Maths

Numbers 0-20

*Pupils will use knowledge of addition and subtraction facts within 10 to add and subtract within 20.

Length

*Pupils will estimate and measure length in cm using a ruler.

Place Value 50 - 100

*The children will identify, compare and find 1 more or less than numbers from 50 - 100.

*Pupils will count efficiently in groups of 2, 5 and 10.

PE - Athetics

*The children will learn and develop their fundamental gross motor skills through running, jumping, throwing and catching.



History- Dinosaurs

*The children will explore the role of fossilized bones and plants in providing information about the dinosaurs.

*The children will create their own picture of a dinosaur skeleton and make inferences about its diet, mobility and temperament from its skeletal features.
